Well here we are again adapting ourselves to being in local lockdown and the rule of six. I do appreciate the fact that you have all been considerate of one another when coming to worship at St Mary's. It is the great Christian tenet that we look after one another and think of others before ourselves.

It has been very difficult for those who are seeking to be married and for those who wish to have their children baptised as the numbers allowed are so low. We will have our first wedding this year in November. Daniel and Charlotte have been attending St Mary's on and off for over a year and have postponed their wedding a couple of times. They can't see an end to the restrictions for the next six months and have decided to go ahead in November with just 15 guests because it is more important to be married than to have a large gathering. It is a brave decision they have made and the right one for them but for others it is heart breaking to not have everyone they wish on their special day.

On Wednesday 7th October and Sunday 11th October we will celebrate Harvest Festival in church. We will as always collect food donations for the Food Bank. If you are able to bring something please place it in a plastic bag and leave it on your seat at the end of the Service so that there is no movement in Church to minimise the risks.

I am going on leave from Tuesday 13th October until Friday 23rd October. It's a bit frustrating not being able to go anywhere. Unfortunately this will mean that the two Wednesday Services at 10.00am will not be eucharistic and will be a said morning prayer. As yet I haven't managed to get cover for Sunday 18th October which has to remain eucharistic. If I can't get anyone to cover then I

will take the service. I realise that this is not ideal and if those who attend on a Wednesday wish to attend twice that week to receive Holy Communion then please do so and Gail, Barbara and Dawn will make sure you are seated appropriately and safely.

I have now finished the Sponsored walk for the East Window. I enjoyed the challenge very much and the last three days were the hardest as I had so many commitments those three days. My thanks go to Lizzy who walked for 3 hours with me on the last day between 4.30 and 7.30 to get the steps done but I finished with a smile. Dave has a picture for the magazine and the picture is on our facebook page. I have been blessed by the weather and I only got rained upon three times.

I am incredulous at the support you have given to me in encouragement and ensuring I am okay but I am amazed at the generosity you have shown. You have raised so far a total of approximately £2,600.00 which is absolutely magnificent and I can't thank you enough.
