Church Re-Opening for Private Prayer and Funerals ONLY

As per the Government and Church of England guidelines we have been able to open the church this past two weeks for Private Prayer ONLY. We have notified our local Funeral Directors that we are able now to carry out funerals. A complete risk assessment has been completed and is available to view on our church website (www.stmarywoodkirk.org).

We have between 8-10 people each time we have opened and it was lovely to see old and new friends alike. We will be open again this next week on Monday 6th July 10.00am-12noon, and Thursday 9th July 6.00pm-8.00pm.

Please remember that Bathrooms will be closed for the time being and you are welcome to bring a cushion and a bible or prayer book on the understanding that only you touch them and you take them home. You will be asked to sanitize your hand on entry and exit into the church.

We have twelve pews available to sit in – if you live alone then only you can sit in a pew, if you are married or in a bubble then you can share a pew.

If you have any symptoms of COVID or are in quarantine then please do not enter into church at this time as others

will be put a risk. If you are in a vulnerable category then again please take care and follow government guidelines.

Church will not be open at other times and no-one (Workmen, PCC members and Volunteers are to enter without explicit permission from the Vicar who needs to keep a record of those who enter for a specific purpose.

SO when will we be open for worship?

The PCC will meet on Monday 13th July and it is likely we will open for worship as soon as we can after that date once all the decisions have made.

I would like to point out that worship will not be as it was before lockdown. It will feel and be very different as we have to work within both Government and Diocese guidelines which are all created and developed to keep you and me as safe as possible. All the risk assessments have been carried out and church has been marked out appropriately for safe distancing. There will be a strict control of movement in and out of the church again to ensure your safety and again we will ask that if you are exhibiting any symptoms of COVID or you are isolating then please do not come to church that week as it puts others at risk.

Detailed information will be sent out next Tuesday and I will hold back next weeks Notice Sheet until that day so that you will be aware of what has been decided and when you can attend for worship. I will also put a video up on Facebook for you to watch.

On a very sad note for our family this week our eldest dog Rosie was put to sleep on Friday. She was sixteen and a half years and had a very good life and certainly enjoyed her last four years in the garden and graveyard. Thank you to all those who made a fuss of her.

We continue to have a virtual coffee morning at 10.30am on Saturday mornings on Zoom. If you haven't attended and would like to join in then you will either need to email me so that I can let you have the access codes to enter the coffee morning or look on our facebook page.

Please continue to pray for those in need that we know.
