We are currently on **Week 2** of our plan – which comes into effect on Weds 28th July.

Singing was introduced last week and will continue with two hymns and sung Eucharist - both church doors need to be open. Holy Communion – one kind only – administered in pews. Tea and coffee will be served after the Service – please sit at tables and you will be served.

Tentative plans for Week 3 and 4:-

We are currently on **Week 3** of our plan – from Weds 4th August which has changed slightly.

I am going to continue to lead from the small altar for the next two weeks. Holy Communion will be in one kind only and will be dispensed from the altar steps – two rows at a time – marshalled by a Warden. You can remove your masks should you wish as you come for communion. It is imperative you don't move until you are invited by the Warden and that you keep a 1m distance between yourselves. There will be no more than 4/5 people in the queue at any one time. One you have received communion please return to your seats. It is only when those 4/5 people have sat down will the next two rows be invited to come for Communion and so on. This may take a little more time but it will more people confidence to move around the church safely.

Singing will remain the same with 2 hymns sung.

Unfortunately, there will be no sung communion today. Please wear masks to sing and both doors should be kept open.

Week 4 – from Weds 11th August

Is likely to be the same as Week 3.

It really doesn't matter how long we take to get back to whatever the new normal will be but it does matter that we keep each other safe and that we consider the vulnerability of others.

My position is this – I will continue to wear a mask for the next month whilst moving around in church, once sat or leading I will remove, however, I will replace mask for singing and for administering Holy Communion though I will dispense of rubber gloves and just use sanitizer.

If you are clinically vulnerable (or simply nervous about returning to church) then please come to the Wednesday morning service at 10.00am which is quieter and therefore more space to sit apart.

With regards to children – having spoken to Neal and seeking his advice regards the rise in cases – the children's corner will not reappear until at least September.

Of course, children are welcome, they must just sit in the pews with their parents/carers.
