So here we are again at the mercy of another lockdown scenario. The Guidelines we have been given are as follows:

Places of Worship will be closed, unless they are being used for:

- Funerals
- To broadcast acts of worship
- Individual prayer
- Formal childcare or where part of a school
- Essential voluntary and public services, such as blood donation or food banks
- Other exempted activities such as some support groups

Funerals can be attended by a maximum of 30 people, and it is advised that only close friends and family attend.

Linked ceremonial events such as stone settings and ash scatterings can also continue with up to 15 people in attendance. Anyone working is not included. Social distancing should be maintained between people who do not live together or share a support bubble.

Weddings, civil partnership ceremonies will not be permitted to take place except in exceptional circumstances.

Churches can open for Private Prayer but it seems to me that it is confused logic to say that a church cannot open for worship and yet can open for individual prayer. It puts people at risk unnecessarily and so at least initially we have made the decision not to open for Private Prayer. However, should anyone wish to pray in church then they

can contact me and it can be arranged on an individual basis.

All Services will be streamed on-line on our Facebook Page and you are welcome to join in – if you follow St Mary's Facebook page then you will be notified of all that we offer in the way of services. Joining instruction on page 4.

With regards to activities in the Parish Hall only those that meet the Government's/Church of England's criteria will continue whilst we are in lockdown. Those groups will be St Mary's Playgroup and Baby Sensory. I understand the Government will review the situation at the beginning of December so I will keep you informed.

It isn't easy to follow these guidelines they do give mixed messages and guidelines themselves are slow in coming out in any detail so I apologise for the lack of a notice sheet last week but I didn't have sufficient correct information to keep you informed.

Somehow this lockdown seems more serious and yet people seem to take it more lightly it defies logic really. There are several members of our congregation and local community who have suffered or are suffering with COVID. Please take care and take no risks and of course if you need anything please contact myself or Gail.

Remembrance Sunday will be held on 8th November at 10.30am and will be streamed live from Church.

PCC Meeting will take place at 8.00pm on Monday 10th November via zoom.
