We are currently on **Week 9** of our plan – from Sun 12th September.

Today we will continue to take Holy Communion from the High Altar using the choir stalls to arrive and leave as normal. Should you wish to kneel at the altar then please do so. Holy Communion will still be in one kind only.

You can remove your masks should you wish as you come for communion or else you can remove them at the altar rail.

Please also come to the altar rail should you wish to have a blessing.

Singing will remain the same with 3 hymns sung and sung communion if Brian is present. Please wear masks to sing and both doors should be kept open.

The PCC will meet tomorrow evening and one of the discussions is around mask wearing. Up until now I have modelled wearing a mask moving around and removing a mask when sitting, and advised that masks need to be worn when singing. As you know there is no legal requirement to wear masks for any of the above but as our church building is quite small I would like to have that discussion before we move forward. I will let you know the outcome of that discussion next week.

What is more important is that we are kind and considerate to each other and to those who are medically vulnerable.

With regards to children – having spoken to Neal and seeking his advice regards the rise in cases – the children's corner will not reappear until at least the end of September.

Of course, children are welcome, they must just sit in the pews with their parents/carers.

Dates to Note:-

Church Open Day will be held on Saturday 18th September between 10.00am - 2.00pm which coincides with Heritage Week. There will be an opportunity to discover more about the church and the churchyard, search for your ancestors etc. There will be a special tour of the windows in church along with some graves in the churchyard. Tea, cake, BBQ etc. All money raised will go towards the Gardening Fund – it means that we can purchase equipment to make the work easier and replace equipment as and when necessary. It also means that we can provide petrol for trimmers and mowers which cost around £40.00 per month.
