Tentative plans for Week 3 and 4:-

We are currently on **Week 4** of our plan – from Weds 11th August and Week 5 of our plan – from Weds 18th which has changed slightly.

I am going to continue to lead from the small altar for the next two weeks. Holy Communion will be in one kind only and will be dispensed from the altar steps – two rows at a time – marshalled by a Warden. You can remove your masks should you wish as you come for communion. It is imperative you don't move until you are invited by the Warden and that you keep a 1m distance between yourselves. There will be no more than 4/5 people in the queue at any one time. Once you have received communion please return to your seats. It is only when those 4/5 people have sat down will the next two rows be invited to come for Communion and so on. This may take a little more time but it will give more people confidence to move around the church safely. Please also come up for a blessing.

Singing will remain the same with 2 hymns sung and sung communion if Brian is present. Please wear masks to sing and both doors should be kept open.

It really doesn't matter how long we take to get back to whatever the new normal will be but it does matter that we keep each other safe and that we consider the vulnerability of others.

My position is this – I will continue to wear a mask for the next month whilst moving around in church, once sat

or leading I will remove, however, I will replace mask for singing and for administering Holy Communion though I will dispense of rubber gloves and just use sanitizer.

If you are clinically vulnerable (or simply nervous about returning to church) then please come to the Wednesday morning service at 10.00am which is quieter and therefore more space to sit apart.

With regards to children – having spoken to Neal and seeking his advice regards the rise in cases – the children's corner will not reappear until at least September.

Of course, children are welcome, they must just sit in the pews with their parents/carers.
