By next week I will have sorted out what we are doing for lent though of course it may be plan a, b or c depending if the government make any announcements. The PCC are due to meet again on Monday 8th February where we will continue to assess our situation with regards to keeping our Services on line for the time being.

The Church of England have given some guidance and Bishop Nick and Bishop Paul have made it clear that they will support decisions taken locally and they have been informed that we have suspended worship for the time being.

A date for your diary would be **Tuesday 16th February which is Shrove Tuesday** so please enjoy your pancakes!

This means that **Ash Wednesday will be on Wednesday 17th February and Lent will begin.**
